Medications

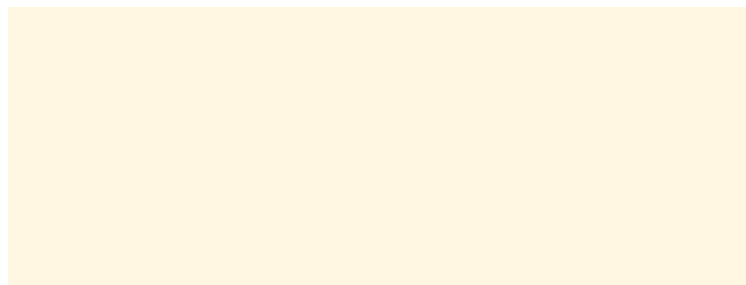
Weather appropriate clothes
